Achimenes

A genus of about 25 species of tropical and subtropical rhizomatous perennial herbs in the flowering plant family Gesneriaceae. They have a multitude of common names such as magic flowers, widow's tears, Cupid's bower, or hot water plant.

Bright funnel shaped flowers from Summer through Autumn



Aeonium haworthii

Aeonium haworthii, also known as Haworth's aeonium or pinwheel, is a species of succulent flowering plant in the family Crassulaceae. A Winter growing succulent, loves full sun, but needs protection from frost



Agapanthus

Large evergreen plant with big blue flowers, likes sun and well-drained soil

Light and dark blue available



Antirrhinum

Dragon flowers, snapdragons and dog flower because of the flowers' fancied resemblance to the face of a dragon that opens and closes its mouth when laterally squeezed.

Perennial but won't survive a hard frost, so usually planted annually.

Comes in many colours



***Aquilegia vulgaris* "Nora Barlow"**

A popular, reliable erect border subject to 80cm, with abundant double flowers of narrow deep pink and pale green petals



Anemone hupehensis

A clump-forming perennial, to 1m tall, with toothed leaves divided into three lobes. Five-petalled flowers, 5-6cm in diameter, are borne from summer into autumn on upright stems. Pale pink flowers



Astrantia 'Hadspen blood'

Superb perennials for light shade under trees and shrubs. Will tolerate drier soils as long as the plants are surrounded with a thick layer of mulch in spring.

Carmine red pincushion flowers on maroon stems.



Aster mixed

Daisy family, flower in Autumn, colourful and a great source of nectar and pollen. Perennials which can be grown in containers.



***Abutilon vitifolium* "album"**

Fast growing small tree with stout grey-felted shoots. Produces an abundance of pendulous white flowers in early summer. Spectacular!



Azara serrata

Commonly known as the saw-toothed azara, *Azara serrata* is an upright, medium-sized shrub with evergreen, ovate leaves that have serrated edges. In late spring and early summer, the foliage is lit up by masses of golden-yellow flowers, which are held in clusters.



Betula pubescens Downy Birch

Native tree with creamy brown bark, upright branches and fine down on young twigs. Long greenish brown catkins and small winged seeds in Autumn.



Blechnum penna-marina

Alpine water fern, forms a carpet of attractive slender fronds, which emerge bronze-red and mature to a fresh green. Shade loving and evergreen, it makes fantastic ground cover in a woodland border. Grow *Blechnum penna-marina* in moist, acidic soil in full to partial shade. Keep well watered during the growing season.



Berkheya purpurea

Perennial with rosettes of spiny leaves. Daisy like flowers of pale mauve with a dark purple centre



Calendula

Annual and perennial herbaceous plants in the daisy family Asteraceae that are often known as marigolds.

Will readily reseed itself and grows easily



Campanula sarmatica

A charming bell-flower species for a sunny spot. Produces lilac –blue flowers on 50cm stems in mid to late summer



Carex pendula

Pendulous Sedge. A very adaptable, woodland sedge, *Carex pendula* is a large, evergreen, clump-forming, perennial grass with erect, arching stems and smooth, mid-green, strap-shaped leaves that grow up to 5'/1.5m long. In May and June, long, drooping, rather catkin-like flowers emerge green, ageing to brown, on arching stems held above the clump of leaves.

Remove catkins before seeds form as it can self-seed vigorously!



Chaenomeles japonica

Japanese quince. A thorny deciduous shrub excellent, in all aspects, for covering ugly walls etc. Its bright red spring flowers followed by apple-shaped edible fruits complement the shiny green leaves



***Choisya ternata* 'Aztec Pearl'**

Compact evergreen medium sized shrub. Abundance of fragrant white flowers in early summer. Earns its place in any garden



Clematis alpina

A medium-sized deciduous climber with leaves divided into 9 narrow-lanceolate leaflets. Flowers light violet-blue, with four tapering sepals to 4cm in length, surrounding cream staminodes and stamens in mid spring to late spring with occasional flowers in midsummer.



Commelina coelestis

Produces a long succession of vivid blue 3-petaled flowers from early summer through to Autumn. Hardy. Increases steadily into a solid clump



Correa reflexa

A prostrate form of the beautiful *Correa reflexa* with tubular cream flowers from late winter to early spring. Ideal for a sheltered spot or a good subject for a container



Correa 'alba'

Very choice small Australian shrub which produces dainty, slender cream bell flowers in winter. Its attractiveness is enhanced by neat round leaves, under surfaces a rust brown



Cotoneaster Coral Beauty

A rounded evergreen shrub with small, glossy dark green leaves and small white flowers followed by orange-red berries



Cyclamen hederifolium

Hardy cyclamen, *Cyclamen hederifolium*, is a pretty hardy perennial, bearing delicate silver-lined dark green leaves reminiscent of ivy, and dainty blooms in shades of pink, in autumn. It's perfect for growing at the base of small shrubs and trees, and naturalising in grass.



Dahlias, single, mixed colours

Good pollinators, will multiply, store or protect the tubers in Winter



Diascia personata

Semi evergreen perennial with robust upright stems to 1m tall. Racemes of small pink flowers with darker pink centres from late Spring into Autumn



Dianella tasmanica

Blue cohosh
Herbaceous evergreen perennial with violet blue flowers, followed in Autumn by glassy blue berries



Dierama pulcherrimum (angels' fishing rods)

Lush green strap-like foliage with long pendulous flower stems with clusters of pink flowers hanging down at the end, just like the bend of a fishing rod. Grows to 1.3 metres and flowers from June to August.



Digitalis mixed colours

Foxglove
Upright herbaceous perennial with tall spires of purple flowers, loved by bees



Epimedium Possiblex versicolour

A deciduous to semi-evergreen low-growing, clump-forming herbaceous perennial with heart shaped leaves, red in spring then turning green. Displays small trumpet like yellow flowers with pink-rose coloured sepals.



Eucomis comosa reuben

A bulbous perennial with dense racemes of starry rose-pink flowers, opening from dark purple buds in mid to late summer. At the tip of the spike sits a rosette of young leaves similar to those of pineapples, hence the common name of Pineapple Lily.



Euphorbia mellifera

Honey spurg, is a handsome, semi-evergreen shrub. Popular garden plant for its honey-scented summer flowers, which are popular with bees, attractive domed growth habit and waxy leaves.

Can be grown in full sun or partial shade,



Euryops pectinatus

A recommended small shrub with hairy, toothed leaves. Rarely without vivid yellow daisy flowers. A great plant to brighten any garden, and lift the spirits!



Ferns, mixed

A mix of hardy ferns, all ideal for a shady spot



Francoa sonchifolia

(pure white and pink) seedlings

Elegant spikes of open flowers, rise from a rosette of mid-green leaves. Great for placing at the front of a border, and very effective in paved areas. These plants grow best in full sun or partial shade in a moist but well drained soil.



Fraxinus Ash

Deciduous graceful tree with pale brown bark. Smooth twigs with black, velvety buds arranged opposite each other. Native to Europe, but from the Olive family.



Mixed Fuchsia

A genus of flowering plants that consists mostly of shrubs or small trees.



Furcraea longaeva

Pale blue-green sword-shaped leaves which grow upwards, like a yucca. Mature plants bear enormous white flower spikes in summer, which sometimes reach heights of more than three metres. Each individual flower on the spike develops into a tiny baby plant, which drops off the stem to root into the soil, while the parent plant eventually dies. It's perfect for adding a touch of drama to an exotic or tropical style border.

Frost tender



Gaura tutti frutti

A compact bushy perennial with small purple flushed green leaves, red stems and large deep pink flowers in Summer and Autumn



Geranium – various varieties

Compact, low-growing plant, which bears masses of various colour flowers in contrast with dark green foliage. It's perfect for growing at the front of a mixed herbaceous border, or in containers on the patio.



Geranium Kashmir White

One of the longest flowering hardy geraniums or cranesbills, *Geranium clarkei* Kashmir White is a hardy, herbaceous perennial with a mound-forming habit.



Geranium Johnson's Blue

Fantastic cranesbill geranium, bearing masses of large, dark-veined, lavender-blue flowers that fade to pearl grey as they mature. It's an informal-looking, slightly sprawling plant that looks best when allowed to spread – it's an excellent choice for groundcover. Perfect for a cottage garden or informal border



Goldfish Plant, Houseplant

Over 25 different varieties. Goldfish HousePlants have hundreds of small, thick, shiny, dark green leaves and colorful flowers that resemble tiny goldfish. The flowers on a Goldfish Plant may be red, orange, or yellow.



Helianthemum yellow queen

Low spreading evergreen shrub with glossy green leaves. Bright yellow saucer shaped flowers with orange markings in the centre



Hesperis matronalis

Sweet rocket is a pretty biennial, bearing white or purple flowers similar to honesty. known for attracting bees, beneficial insects, butterflies/moths and other pollinators. It is a caterpillar food plant and has nectar/pollen rich flowers.



Hosta

Variety a surprise!

These shade-loving plants are primarily grown for their beautiful foliage. There's a vast range of cultivars to choose from, with leaves in all shades of green, as well as dusky blues and acid yellows, sometimes variegated or flashed with cream or gold, ruffled, smooth or distinctively ribbed. Many also produce small trumpet-shaped mauve or white flowers in summer. Hostas are notoriously irresistible to slugs and snails, but are also much loved by gardeners, who often amass large collections.



Hydrangea Runaway Bride

Rounded, deciduous shrub to 1.2m tall and wide with ovate, dark green, serrated leaves. From spring through to autumn, lacecap white flowers, some flushed with pale pink, are borne in profusion on semi-trailing stems; flowers emerge from both lateral and terminal buds.



Inula

Perennial forming a colony of erect, softly hairy stems to 75cm in height, bearing lance-shaped leaves and 1 - 3 light yellow flower-heads to 8cm across, in late summer and autumn



Iris confusa

Bamboo iris, upright perennial with bamboo like stems. Pale blue and white flowers in Spring

Named because it is often confused with other plants



***Iris x germanica* "Jane Phillips"**

'Jane Phillips' is a herbaceous perennial to 1m in height with greyish foliage and light blue scented flowers in early summer, the falls whitish with darker veins at the base and a white beard



Iris sibirica blue king

Flag iris with deep violet flowers with veined yellow throats.



Iris Unguicularis

The Algerian Iris, is one of the delights of the winter garden. It is a perennial plant, growing from rhizomes which spread with ease when planted in a soil which is free-draining and in full sun. It grows to about 30cm. high and the flowers signal the start of winter and what a delightful start with such beauty and such hope as these delicate blossoms brave the worst weather of the year and yet look so beautiful



Jasminum nudiflorum

Reliable shrub, widely grown as a wall shrub. It can be allowed to scramble freely over a low wall or up a bank or trained up a vertical framework. Unlike many other jasmines, *Jasminum nudiflorum* does not twine, so will need tying-in if grown vertically. The stems are bright green and give an evergreen impression, even in winter when the tiny bright yellow blooms appear.



Kniphofia uvaria yellow/red

Clump-forming perennial to 1.5m tall with long, narrow leaves up to 1.4m in length and 3cm wide. Large, oblong heads of flowers are borne on tall spikes from summer into autumn; reddish-orange buds open to greenish-yellow flowers



Leycesteria formosa

Pheasant berry or Himalayan honeysuckle is a deciduous shrub, very attractive to wild-life.

Tolerates any conditions, suitable for a container



Tree Lily

Bulbous plant
Will reach 6-7 foot tall in a few years Produces masses of large lily flowers
Pink and Orange varieties



Ligularia

The Rocket is a handsome perennial, bearing tall, black stems of bright yellow flowers over large, toothed foliage in summer.



Lippia Citriodora

Lemon Verbena

Shrub with strongly lemon scented leaves, which can be used in cooking, for pot pourri, to make tea, oil etc



Lobelia tupa

Unusual plant from Chile, can reach 2.5m. Dramatic downy foliage, dark red-purple stems, blood-red tubular flowers.

Not fully hardy, likes shelter and sun

Best in moist soil



Lunaria 'Corfu Blue'

Honesty Blue-purple flowers, purple-flushed stems and seedpods, lovely. Blooms sporadically throughout year. Hardy perennial !



Luma apiculata Chilian myrtle

Large evergreen shrub, older branches have a cinnamon and cream bark.

Aromatic leaves and white flowers, purple berries



Maianthemum bifolium (lily of the valley)

Spreading herbaceous perennial with pairs of large, glossy, dark green, heart-shaped leaves, 3 in. long (8 cm), arising directly from rhizomes. In late spring to early summer, sprays of 15-20 star-shaped white flowers are held just above the foliage.



Maurendella anthurriniflora

A rare native perennial herb that grows in southern California. It is fast growing and moderately long-lived. It grows in a rounded form to a height of 0.8 feet, with active growth during the spring. Flowers are purple and striking, and bloom in the mid spring. Leaves are medium green and deciduous.



***Monstera deliciosa* (indoor house plant)**

Swiss cheese plant or split-leaf philodendron, evergreen, sensitive to over watering, needs lots of light, large glossy leaves.

Easy house plant



***Muscari aucheri* 'White Magic'**

Bulbs in compost

Perennial bearing small bell-shaped tubular flowers in Spring. Excellent container plant.



***Olearia phlogopappa* "Combers Blue"**

A medium sized bush covered in blue daisy flowers from early spring well into early summer



Ophiopogon planiscapus Nigrescens

A small evergreen perennial growing to 20 cm tall, from short rhizomes, and bears tufts of grasslike leaves, from which purple or white flowers emerge in racemes held on short stems above the leaves. Happy with sun or shade, it has many common names including Black Dragon, Ebony Knight or Black Mondo Grass



Penstemon Emily

Bushy plants bear plenty of upright stems of almost-white, large flared bells, each tinged with pink at the mouth. A beautiful plant that mixes well with many other plants. Cut back after the first flowering and it will repeat bloom. 60cm x 40cm.



Persicaria Red Dragon

Unusual herbaceous plant, grown for its foliage rather than flowers. Each leaf is sharply pointed, with maroon and green patterning and a pale white margin. It quickly develops into a handsome, upright clump.



Phlox paniculata Rosa Pastell

Beautiful pink flowers on this phlox, spreads easily, grows in any conditions



Phlox paniculate Brighteyes

Beautiful pink flowers with a deeper pink center. Spreads easily, grows in any conditions



Primula alpicola moonlight primrose

A compact, herbaceous perennial to 50cm tall with rosettes of green, oval to lance-shaped leaves. In early summer, dense clusters of fragrant, funnel-shaped flowers in shades of white, cream, yellow or purple are held on a stem arising from the centre of the leaf rosette. Occasionally a second flowering stem will be produced



Mixed Pseudopanax

An unusual evergreen tree from New Zealand grown for its striking leaves and shape. Can be grown in a pot.



Phlomis russelliana

Turkish sage, hairy perennial to 90cm in height, soft yellow flowers



Prostanthera cuneata

A very rewarding, unusual small shrub. Aromatic leaves and masses of purple flowers in early summer



Polemonium caeruleum album

Jacob's Ladder' forms dense clumps of dainty foliage with lots of stems of clear white flowers in late spring and early summer. Very easy to grow.



Pulmonaria sp.

Spring flowering low-growing perennial with attractive spotted foliage and blue/purple/pink flowers. Good for early pollinators



Raspberry

Variety nknown
Fruits in
Autumn
Great cropper, cut entire plant to ground in
December Fruits Sep-Nov



Renga Renga

Arthropodium cirratum is a species of herbaceous perennial plant, endemic to New Zealand, where it may once have been farmed. It is used for medicine as well as food, and has symbolic importance in traditional Māori culture.

Often called rock lily, it has a tidy form and likes dry shade



Rosa banksii 'alba'

An enormous, gorgeously scented rose, *Rosa banksiae Alba Plena* is a vigorous, fast-growing, rambling rose, almost thornless and semi-evergreen. It does best trained against a warm, sunny, sheltered wall, where it will take up a great deal of room, but can also be trained through a sturdy tree or over a strong shed



Rudbeckia Goldstrum

Wide, black-eyed, single, yellow daisy flowers with cone-shaped, black-brown centres from August to October



Saponaria ocymoides

Rock soapwort or tumbling Ted, is a species of semi-evergreen perennial flowering plant. Outstanding ground cover for sun and part sun areas.



Mixed Salvias

As well as the specific *Salvias* mentioned below, we have a variety of other *Salvias*.

Part of the mint family, they have colourful spikes of flowers in Autumn, some right through early Winter.



Slavia pratensis

Salvia with violet blue flowers



Salvia Love and Wishes

Aromatic foliage, dark stems and masses of rich, dark pink-purple flowers from May to October.

Plants form a bushy habit, making 'Love and Wishes' perfect for growing in a container on the patio. For best results, grow in well-drained soil, in full sun.



Sarcococca hookeriana var. digyna

Small, suckering evergreen shrub with green or purplish stems, narrowly lanceolate mid-green leaves and clusters of small, creamy-white, divinely fragrant flowers and black berries.



Sedum

Both red and yellow flowering

Fleshy leaved succulents, likes a sunny condition



Stipa Tenuissima 'Pony Tails'

Graceful ornamental grass with silvery green leaves in late Spring. Abundant feathery panicles all Summer which are wonderful in flower arrangements



Strawberry Plants

Wild, delicious small berries



Uncinia rubra

This striking coloured sedge adds rich, contrasting colour and texture to any border. Attractive subject in a pot



Verbascum chaxii album

white nettle-leaved mullein

'Album' is a perennial forming a rosette of greyish-hairy leaves, with a narrow panicle of white flowers with purple centres, in late summer

Grow in alkaline, poor, well-drained soil in full sun; drought-tolerant plant. In fertile soils, it grows large and needs support



Vinca

Tough, low-maintenance, and pest-free, (commonly known as periwinkle) with pretty broadleaf foliage and flowers. It is also useful for providing ground cover and is known for its creeping habit. Vinca minor vines most commonly put out a blue flower in spring, but the color can also be lavender, purple, or white



Verbena bonariensis

Tall, narrow, sparsely-leaved stems on top of which flattened heads of bright lavender-purple flowers appear in late-summer. It's perfect for bringing height to an ornamental border and also works well in prairie-style

planting schemes with ornamental grasses. It's a superb butterfly plant,



Viola arborescens

Tree violet, average height is anywhere from 8 to 10 inches. *Viola arborescens* requires direct sunlight to grow. Very cold hardy, and is in bloom all winter and into early spring.



Weigela 'Bristol Ruby'

One of the most dependable, attractive, and showy medium sized shrubs. Masses of red trumpet flowers are produced middle to late spring



Zantedeschia

Calla Lily

White and black, can be grown outside in mild areas, in moist soil.

Bold and exotic looking with large fluted flowers
